COVID-19 Preparedness Plan

To ensure that the Let's Go Fishing – Fairmont Chapter provides a safe and healthy experience for both our LGF volunteers and the patrons we serve this COVID-19 Preparedness Plan will be practiced throughout the LGF 2021 fishing and boat cruising season. All LGF volunteers will be fully trained to consistently follow these guidelines.

- All patrons, facility staff and LGF volunteers must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 to board the boat.
- LGF volunteers who are sick, do not feel well or have a fever are asked to stay at home for 10 days. If they have had contact with anyone who has COVID-19 they need to stay at home for 10 days and not return to volunteering until they have a negative test result.
- All patrons, facility staff and LGF volunteers will wear a mask from the time they arrive at the boating site until they have departed. If a patron or LGF volunteer arrives without a mask, a mask will be provided by LGF.
- Fishing trips will be limited to 4 individuals including the facility staff. Cruising excursions will be limited to 6 individuals including facility staff. This limited number of individuals on the boat will allow for seating to be arranged to provide social distancing.
- All surfaces on the boat that come in contact with patrons, facility staff and LGF volunteers will be sanitized after each trip. Hand sanitizer will be available for use by patrons, facility staff and LGF volunteers at all times.
- All fishing equipment that was used will be sanitized after each fishing trip, stowed in the on-board storage box and not reused before the following day.
- All life jackets will be sanitized at the end of each trip. Those life jackets will be set aside and not reused before the following day.
- The patrons' facility staff will be asked to escort each patron individually to and from the boat. When necessary LGF volunteers will assist in seeing that the patrons are escorted to and from the boat safely.
- These guidelines may be adjusted throughout the 2021 Let's Go Fishing season as we continue to follow the CDC most current best practices.
